A Record of *Perccottus glenii* (Pisces, Odontobutidae) in Khmelnitsky Region [Haxoдкa *Perccottus glenii* (Pisces, Odontobutidae) в Хмельницкой области]. — Amur sleeper (*Perccottus glenii* Dubowski, 1877) the Far-East invader was recorded during the ichthyological investigation of the Sluch River (tributary of the Horyn of the Dniper basin) in July 2013 near the village Sakhnivtsi (Khmelnitsky region). This is the first record of this species in Khmelnitsky region. We caught about 150 specimens of length from 5 to 13 cm and weight of 5.5 to 71.5 g. Amur sleeper dominated in the sampled sites, the river and an oxbow lake that can be characterized by slow-flowing to stagnant water, muddy bottom and aquatic plant abundance. — A. O.
